

Re: Brock Ward Boundary Review

Further to our letter of February 27, 2021, we have subsequently reviewed the Final Report of the Brock Ward Boundary Review, kindly forwarded by the Township Clerk.

As you know, we did not take a position on which Option we believe Council should choose, but only asked that the principles outlined by the consultants be upheld along the shoreline roads of Thorah Park Boulevard, Maple Beach and Cedarhurst Road and Cedarhurst Beach Road so that they are aligned into the same Ward.

We believe it makes no sense to complete this important process and not, at the very least, realign these 22 properties that are part of a contiguous shoreline road. To do so will create a coherent community of interest and provide clarity to the future Ward boundary.
